White #PC938
 Black #PC935
 Colorless Blender
 True Blue #PC903
 Warm Grey 20% #PC1051
 Warm Grey 50% #PC1054
 Warm Grey 70% #PC1056
 Rosy Beige #PC1019
 Lavender PC#934
 Crimson Red #PC924
 Mineral Orange PC#1033
 Celadon Green PC#1020
 Verithin White #734
 Verithin Black #747

Supplies Needed:

- Paper Surface will be provided
- Prismacolor Premier Pencils (listed below photo)
- ¼" acrylic paint brush
- Tiny container for Odorless thinner (provided in class)
- Tracing paper to transfer design
- Fine ball point pen for tracing, like Zebra
- Dark Grey graphite to transfer design
- Paper towels for cleanup and masking
- Low Tack Artist tape
- Erasers (light or dark based on the color of the surface paper)
- Superglue for pencil tip repairs. A tiny bit will restore the tip. It can also be used to secure two stubs.
- Clipboard to secure paper, or hard chipboard surface and padded clips to secure the surface, but not damage paper or surface.
